

PSA JOURNAL MEDALLIONS

Established in 2007, the *PSA Journal* Medallions were designed to recognize the many contributors to the *Journal* of the Photographic Society of America. The *Journal* Medallions have ribbons allowing the recipient to wear this "thank you" and are meant to be worn at PSA conferences, PSA Chapter meetings, and similar photographic events. PSA hopes that seeing the medallions will interest others in writing for the magazine!

There are three kinds of recognition with ribbons as follows:

• **Red, White & Blue ribbon:**

This group of Medallion is for PSA Members who have been awarded one of the Annual Editorial Awards:

- * The **Chatham Memorial** award for the best feature article of the previous year.
- * The **Keaton Memorial** award is given for ten or more years of contributing feature articles.

• **Gold ribbon:**

The *Journal* Medallion with the Gold ribbon is for a PSA member that earned one or more Gold stars for their many contributions to the *PSA Journal* over many years.

• **Red & Black ribbon:**

Quarterly since mid 2002, the *Journal* has showcased some of the finest photographers in the Society, each time with a subject designated by the *Journal*. Featured photographers are invited by the *Journal* and the article is the centerfold story with the cover photo as well.
